

Information Regarding Social Security Benefits

The funeral home notifies Social Security about the passing of your loved one. However, you will also want to be in contact with them, because you may be entitled to certain benefits. Social Security has a one-time death benefit of \$255 that may be paid to a surviving spouse or dependent child.

Additionally, other benefits might be available if the family meets certain requirements such as: spouse over the age of 60, or minor children still residing in the home. This list of requirements is **not** comprehensive and we encourage you to contact the Social Security Administration for your individual circumstance.
